

## Desktop Information Tag (DI-TAG)

The Desktop Information Tag (DI-Tag) was developed to “stamp” the computer’s details on to the desktop. This is done in a similar way as with the well-know utility BGInfo from SysInternals. Furthermore, an icon appears in the System Tray with which the user can update this information.




## Benefits

Benefits when using the Desktop Information Tag:

- Information from the environment, the registry, the WMI or short info-texts e.g. the help desk telephone number, can be displayed.
- The user can answer help desk queries more easily with the DI Tag. A glance at the desk top is enough.
- The administrator can pre-define the details to be shown in a configuration file (xml). Furthermore, the appearance can be adjusted as desired (font size and type, background color, position, transparency etc.)





- DI-Tag stamps the information onto the desktop thus making it visible even when the pc is locked.
- DI-Tag imbeds itself fully in existing background images, irrespective of whether they are defined as Center, Tile or Stretch.
-  An application that is only held in main storage for a few seconds - while updating the desktop. The system tray icon is a separate application (C) thereby saving main storage.
